

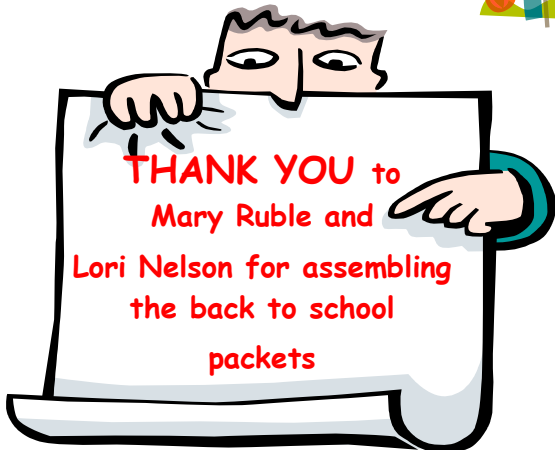

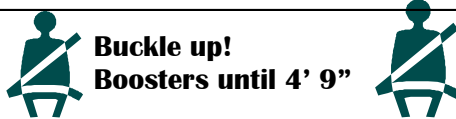

Breakfast & Lunches Served

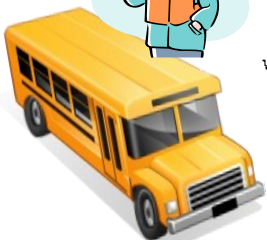
The prices for paid lunches will increase for 2008-2009 to enable us to keep up the quality and variety of our program in the face of increasing food and fuel and labor costs.

Elementary Schools:	Breakfast	\$1.75	Lunch	\$2.75
Adults:	Breakfast	\$2.75	Lunch	\$3.75
Milk:	Breakfast	\$.50	Lunch	\$.50

Students who are reduced will get breakfast free this year, and reduced students in grades K-3 will get lunch free. Reduced students in grades 4-5 will have to pay \$.40 for lunch. If you think your family qualifies for free or reduced lunch, contact the office for the forms.

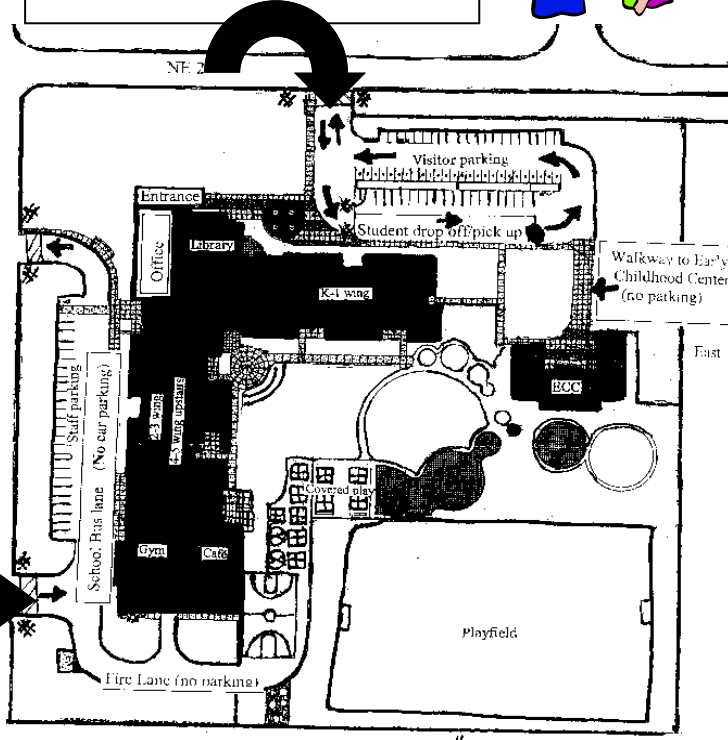
